- 2009 Global Recession

 - Ontario loses position as Canada's economic engine
- Demographic Shifts

 - Immigration key to growth




Cornwall's Position

 - » Below national and provincial levels








- New forensic building (13,000 sf) to follow in 2010






 - \$15 million Courthouse now complete

















