CORNWALL, ONTARIO

Situated in the heart of Central Canada, and with world class recreational facilities, Cornwall is an ideal choice for major sporting events.

Cornwall is located on the north shore of the St. Lawrence River, just west of the Ontario - Quebec border. Ottawa and Montreal are only an hour away, and Canada's busiest expressway, Highway 401, intersects the city.

REMARKABLE FACILITIES

Cornwall is home to several world-class modern facilities, many of which host dozens of tournaments and sporting events each year.


Facilities include the Benson Centre, a versatile facility with 3 ice rinks, indoor field house and tennis court. It is rivaled perhaps only by the Civic Complex, which includes a 5,000 seat arena, aquatic centre and adjacent curling club. The two facilities are linked by the Waterfront Trail, which is home to a variety of running and cycling events, including the popular Cornwall Triathlon.

ROBUST ACCOMMODATIONS

Cornwall can house hundreds of visiting athletes in the 1000+ hotel rooms in the City. Many hotels have extensive meeting facilities, including the Best Western Parkway Inn and Ramada Hotel. Unique to the area is the NAV CENTRE, an internationally recognized conference centre that includes over 560 rooms, on-site fitness centre and several multi-purpose rooms.

A PEDIGREE OF HOSTING SUCCESSFUL EVENTS

From the RBC Cup to the Canadian Golden Glove Championships, Cornwall has a long history of hosting successful events. The community has a strong base of volunteers with experience in running multi-day events. Over 5 million people are within a 90 minute drive of Cornwall, making it easy to attract out of town spectators. Ottawa and Montreal media regularly cover Cornwall sporting events.

BENSON CENTRE



A state-of-the-art athletic facility, able to handle several different sporting competitions at the same time. The Benson Centre is one of Eastern Ontario's newest multi-sport facilities, built in 2011 at a cost of \$32 million. The versatile facility features three ice rinks and an indoor field house, complimented by several meeting rooms and a full concession service. Major hotels and restaurants are just minutes away.

CIVIC COMPLEX



One the largest and best-equipped facilities in Eastern Ontario, the Cornwall Civic Complex is a versatile building located on the banks of the scenic St. Lawrence River.

The Cornwall Civic Complex is located in the heart of Downtown Cornwall, a short walk from restaurants and shopping. It is the hub of Lamoureux Park, and with the adjoining Aquatic Centre and adjacent Curling Centre, it is a popular choice for a wide variety of sporting events.



AQUATIC CENTRE



The Aquatic Centre provides a modern indoor swimming facility twelve months of the year and is an ideal choice for swimming and aquatic sports. The Aquatic Centre is connected to the Civic Complex, with its own separate entrance as well as direct access to the larger facility. The Aquatic Centre features a world class pool along with a two-storey water slide, toddler leisure pool and whirlpool. The Aquatic Centre has hosted a number of swimming and underwater hockey sporting events.

CURLING CENTRE



One of Ontario's oldest curling clubs enjoys a modern state of the art curling facility.

The Cornwall Curling Centre is located along the banks of the St. Lawrence River, adjacent to the Cornwall Civic Complex and Aquatic Centre. This facility was built in 2004 and is home to over 500 curlers. The Curling Centre hosts a variety of bonspiels throughout the year.

Recently the Curling Centre has hosted events such as the Shorty Jenkins Classic, the 2015 Ontario Police Bonspiel, the 2015 Travelers Curling Club Championship, and the 2014 Dominion Curling Club Provincial Championship Finals.

WATERFRONTTRAIL



A recreational ribbon along the river's edge. Cornwall has a comprehensive network of approximately 40 kilometres of recreational paths that allow people to walk, bike and rollerblade along the St. Lawrence River and throughout the City.

The largest part of the recreational path spans the entire waterfront, offering great views of the St. Lawrence River. This part of the recreational path is also part of Ontario's Waterfront Trail, which stretches from Niagara-on-the-Lake to the Quebec border. Cornwall's recreation path connects neighbourhoods to a number of attractions including Lamoureux Park and Guindon Park. The Path has played host to a number of triathlons, road races and cycling events.

HOTELS AND AMENITIES

Visitors are accommodated in the more than 900 hotel and motel rooms that are available within a 10 minute drive of downtown Cornwall. Many of these facilities also offer added value, including meeting rooms, on-site restaurants and event planning assistance.







RAMADA HOTEL AND **CONFERENCE CENTRE**

The Ramada Hotel is situated on Brookdale Avenue, just minutes from the Benson Centre. The 112 room hotel offers an onsite restaurant, indoor pool, large parking lot with Tesla Supercharger station and 9 versatile meeting rooms.

BEST WESTERN PLUS PARKWAY **INN & CONFERENCE CENTRE**

The Best Western is a well appointed full service facility on Brookdale Avenue. The 97 room hotel offers an onsite restaurant, outdoor pool, large parking lot and meeting facilties that can accommodate up to 250 people.

CORNWALL COMFORT INN

The Comfort Inn is located on Vincent Massey Drive in the City's west end and offers 110 well appointed quest rooms. The facility includes a heated indoor saltwater pool and exercise room for guest enjoyment.

ST. LAWRENCE COLLEGE

St. Lawrence College sits on the banks of the St. Lawrence River and is a popular staging site for races along the Waterfront Trail. The campus includes a large gymnasium, cafeteria, fitness centre, ample onsite parking and during the summer, access to dorm rooms.

NAV CENTRE



Located on the scenic shores of the St. Lawrence River, the NAV CENTRE is a full service conference centre offering access to 560 guest rooms and 70 dedicated state-of-the-art meeting rooms. It has a number of other key amenities including an on-site restaurant, pub, spa and fitness centre with indoor pool. The NAV CENTRE is a member of the International Association of Conference Centres.

The NAV CENTRE site includes over 70 acres of parkland with immediate access to the Waterfront Trail, a recreational path that extends for kilometres along the St. Lawrence River. The facility is owned and operated by NAV CANADA.


