










Tips for finding a job

The average price of a single family detached home sold in Cornwall is \$420,000.


Cornwall's housing prices make it easier for young families to buy a home.

When it comes to great shopping and dining, local residents find everything they need right here in town. In fact, Cornwall's shops and restaurants attract people from across the region and beyond.


