



## Human Trafficking Educator

SASS is an organization that supports female identified survivors of sexual violence. With new funding opportunity we will be addressing the problem of human trafficking, more specifically sex trafficking within SDG &A. We are focusing our human trafficking program on prevention, community awareness, and collaboration with local partners. This position would directly support SASS's mission to end all forms of sexual violence.

As part of its prevention initiatives, the program will address the root cause of gender-based violence, exploitation, and unhealthy relationships through mentoring & education. As a primary prevention program, it aims to build protective factors in elementary and middle school youth, by supporting parents and educators. It will work with the community to help identify HT victims/survivors and provide resources as needed. Through curriculum development, on-line training and mentorship, we hope to shine a light on human trafficking in our community.

### **PRIMARY DUTIES & KEY TASKS:**

- Conduct literature review of evidence-based approaches to engage and activate youth in the prevention of gender-based violence and document best practices and tools for youth/male engagement
- Assist in the preparation & implementation of training to educators, parents, community members and business community with focus on the tourism industry.
- Support the creation of online programming and training.
- Help build systems to track the number of teachers, students, and community members trained through online and in-person programs.
- Update relationship management tools to develop and maintain outreach channels with schools and partners currently implementing HT training programs and those looking to implement them in the future.
- Improve and expand school vulnerability analysis to improve program targeting in high-risk schools and districts.
- Maintain and develop relationships with community partners.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Minimum college degree in social services or related field preferred; a minimum of 2 years' experience in social work, mental health, victims rights, substance abuse; or 2-4 years of experience volunteering &/or working in human trafficking or sexual violence.
