

TRAINING

Technical Skills: Delivered by St. Lawrence College, the Environmental Service Aide program will help participants prepare for employment in the health care sector. The course addresses all aspects of the healthcare cleaning profession, the importance of proper techniques and practices to reduce the risk of infection. The course includes recommendations by the Provincial Infection Control Advisory Committee (PIDAC) pertaining to the Best Practice Cleaning Document for Environmental Cleaning.

Technical Skills: Delivered by St. Lawrence College, the Cooking & Catering program will help participants prepare for employment in restaurants, catering companies, hotels, hospitals, nursing homes and more. There will be a

focus on food and key cooking techniques that will be both studied and practiced. Participants will learn knife skills, kitchen safety, meal preparation, and planning, and cooking methods.

TRAINING

Technical Skills:

Three weeks of driver training delivered by Transport Training Centers of Canada. Week one will consist of in-class theory training, followed by two weeks of practical, hands-on driving experience. The Association of Ontario Road Supervisors will also deliver 2 day Snow Plow Operator training.
