The Ahkwesàhsne Mohawk Board of Education (AMBE) was created in 1985 by the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne (MCA). AMBE is responsible for providing educational and Child Care services to the Akwesasne Mohawk Community, including; 3 Child Care Centers and 3 Schools that offer K4 to Grade 8 education; coordination of secondary education service in partnership with local school boards; adult education services; and post-secondary assistance. The Akwesasne Mohawk Community includes about 13,000 Peoples, and borders on the Canadian Provinces of Ontario and Quebec and the American State of New York.

Position Summary:

Under the supervision of the Associate Director of Post Secondary & Continuing Education, the Language & Culture Instructor is responsible for development and delivery of training to staff and students on traditional knowledge and practices. The Language & Culture Instructor will also recommend ways to improve and facilitate inclusion of traditional knowledge in Iohahio programs and services. The incumbent will plan and teach language courses as required in posts-secondary and adult learning programs. The incumbent will collaborate with the AMBE Language & Culture Superintendent to ensure program consistency throughout the system.

Qualifications:

- Fluent Kaniehk'eha Speaker; and
- Extensive knowledge in Mohawk traditional and cultural teachings and methods.
