The GNPLC is one of 25 innovative clinics in the province that enables Nurse Practitioners, Registered Nurses and a interdisciplinary team of health professionals to work to their full scope of practice, to deliver the highest quality of client care.

We are recruiting a **RN or RPN (17.5 hours per week)** to complement our vibrant primary care team, with access to HOOPP and a wellness spending account.

Key Areas of Responsibility and Duties include:

- Providing primary care health assessment, diagnostic and customized treatment planning within the RN/ RPN scope of practice and best practice guidelines.
- Performing venipuncture and point of care testing (urine / HCG /Rapid Strep Throat) as required and directed under the RN(EC) and in adherence to infection control standards.
- Leading the development and implementation of a chronic disease program (e.g Cardio PREVENT, hypertension etc.)
- Utilizing medical directives provided where scope of care and practice falls outside of the RN's scope of practice under the directions of a Nurse Practitioner.
- Documenting client care activity concisely and accurately according to College Guidelines and Care Standards.
- Delivering health teaching and coaching on disease prevention and healthy lifestyle practices such as safe medication use, physical activity, smoking cessation and mental wellness.
- Supporting clients in their understanding and management of chronic disease(s).
- Facilitating clients access to community resources and supports by way of referral and advocacy.
- Collaborating with inter-professional team members to implement customized care plans based on best practices.

Qualifications:

- University undergraduate degree or college diploma in Nursing from an accredited university or college.
- Current member in good standing with the College of Nurses of Ontario.
- At least 2 years practical nursing care experience within a community health/ public health or acute care setting.
- Demonstrated skills in health coaching and chronic disease management (COPD; Hypertension; DM etc).
- Experience developing and facilitating group health education events.
- Proficiency in the use of computers and various EMR applications.
- Committed to implementing comprehensive client care practices within a client centered and continuous quality improvement framework.
- English proficiency is required and a proficiency in French is an asset.
