Key Areas of Responsibility and Duties include:

- Performing individualized biopsychosocial assessments and screening to determine a clients psycho-social needs, risks, urgency and acuity across the lifespan;
- Devising personalized plans of action in collaboration with the client, caregiver and primary care team based on best practices;
- Delivering time-limited evidence based services including brief therapy, crisis intervention, mental wellness and psycho-educational supports;
- Fostering client skill development in areas such as mental well-being, problem solving, communication and positive coping strategies (1:1 or group format);
- Facilitating system navigation and care coordination with community resources/ services (eg.: Ontario Works, ODSP, housing and child care) and
- Diligently monitoring, recording and reporting changes in clinical presentation.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate or Masters degree of Social Work, Clinical Psychology or other Behavioral Science;
- A member of the Ontario College of Social Workers & Social Service Workers or other regulatory college;
- Recent mental health sector experience preferably within a community or out-patient setting;
- Demonstrated competency supporting clients experiencing anxiety, depression, trauma and substance abuse;
- Excellent knowledge of community resources to foster referrals and service linkage;
- Versed in the principals of health equity, the social determinants of health and client advocacy;
- English proficiency is required and a proficiency in French is an asset.
