Job Title: Sprayer

Reports To: Production Manager

Job Summary

The Sprayer, under the direction of the Production Manager, will primarily be responsible to operate a spray gun to apply the spray material to the acrylic shells to a consistent thickness in accordance with target weights. The Sprayer must understand the operations of the spray equipment and be able to troubleshoot and make minor repairs and adjustments.

Competencies

- Economical - Ensures work is completed in a way that is conscientious of company resources.
- Attention to Detail - Attends to details and pursues quality in the accomplishment of tasks, regardless of the volume of duties encountered.
- Commitment to Health and Safety - Works in compliance with all applicable health and safety legislation and established policies and procedures.
- Teamwork - Works cooperatively and effectively with others to reach a common goal. Participates actively in group activities fostering a team environment.
- Resourceful – Responds to difficult situations or workplace requirements by using the available tools and information to support decisions and solutions.

Job Duties

- Ensure compliance with company policies and standards for cost control, waste reduction, quality, safety, and complete and on-time delivery
- Ensure high standards of workmanship and efficiency
- Ensure outputs meet production schedules, safety and quality standards
- Primary responsibility will be to spray acrylic shells to meet the desired criteria.
- Maintain, clean, and troubleshoot minor issues with the spray equipment and report any equipment problems to the Production Manager
- Responsible for general duties involving physical handling of product, materials and supplies used in the spray booth
- Follow manufacturing and processing procedures, set machine or equipment controls, carry out production and inspection processes
- Resolve work problems and recommend measures to improve productivity, product quality, and safety
- Adhere to established safe working procedures and wear the proper safety equipment at all times
- Ensure proper use of required personal protective equipment at all times
- Lubricate, clean, maintain, and repair machinery, equipment, and tools used in the spray booth



- Closely monitor spray equipment for signs of problems while ensuring output is meeting set specifications
- Perform daily maintenance and safety checks on all equipment and tools
- Mark, record, and report defective products
- Communicate with production manager, team leader and other plant personnel for assignments and to resolve equipment, production or quality issues
- Perform booth maintenance duties daily
- Help during end of day plant clean up
- Fill in when needed on various jobs

Job Requirements

- Ability to work individually as well as part of a team
- Dedication to safety measures and best practices
- Knowledge of tool and equipment safety
- Knowledge of workplace safety legislation and safe lifting and handling procedures
- Ability to operate required equipment in a safe and responsible manner
- Ability to perform strenuous physical labour
- Knowledge and understanding of WHMIS required
- Must be able to understand and communicate in English (written and verbal) and possess math skills (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions)
- Ability to prioritize and manage conflicting demands
- Demonstrated ability to operate material-handling equipment
- Lift truck license an asset

Work Conditions

- Should not have any lifting restrictions, frequent lifting of up to 110 kg with the assistance of another employee
- Lifting, moving, or manipulating bulky and heavy objects with required assistance
- Environment may be extremely busy and noisy. Temperature will fluctuate throughout plant and will vary from cool to hot and humid.
- Exposure to hazards associated with the industry
- Use of required personal protective equipment
